Volleyball Tournament Information

1. Time-outs will be 60-seconds in length. The home team is listed first on the schedule. A coin flip will be determined under the discretion of the R1 (lead official).
2. For team warm-ups we will be doing the following:
 - a. Two Minutes Shared
 - b. Three Minutes Serving Team
 - c. Three Minutes Receiving Team
3. Warm-up volleyballs will not be provided.
4. There will be one head official (R1) for each match provided. When your team is officiating, you need to supply one official (R2), two scorekeepers, one scoreboard operator and two line-judges. Please supply your own whistle for the R2 that must be used under a mask.
5. Every team will play at least four matches, all best 2 out of 3 with the first two sets to 25 points and the third to 15 points. No cap in any set.
6. Teams, please pick up around your bench and where you “set-up shop” in the bleachers or in the balcony. **COACHES/PARENTS PLEASE ENFORCE THIS!**
7. We will not be using the AES scheduling system, results will be kept on poster boards for all fans, coaches and players to utilize. They are located in the hallway between the gyms.
8. We will not have a trainer. We do have minimal first-aid supplies in the concession stand.
9. For tiebreaking procedures, we will be using PROTOCOL #1.
For all two-way ties:
The #1 team will be the team that won the pool play match between the two tied teams.
All other ties:
Teams qualifying for playoffs shall be determined by:
 1. Match Winning Percentage (Matches won divided by matches played)
 2. Set Winning Percentage (Sets won divided by sets played)
 3. Total Point Differential (Total # of points won subtracted from total # of points lost)
 4. Coin Flip
10. For the G12 tournament we WILL NOT be using the step-in rule due to it being at the end of the season for most teams.

COVID-19 Protocols

1. Spectators, officials, players and coaches **are required** to wear masks while they are in the building. **Coaches, please enforce the mask policy with your teams which means over their mouth AND nose.** If spectators cannot or will not comply to this policy please take advantage of our live streaming option. Streaming costs \$8.00 a day and you can select multiple courts to follow the athlete throughout the tournament.
2. Please don't be the coach, team or spectator that gets "tattled" on because they are not wearing a mask.
3. Hand sanitizer available at score tables and as you enter the facility.
4. We are one of the only facilities that does not have a parent/spectator limit so it will be crowded. If this is worrisome for you please stay home and enjoy the matches via our live-stream option. **We are thrilled to be able to host tournaments without a spectator policy and provide an opportunity to watch your loved one in person. Please follow our mask policy.**
5. Although it is not part of their job description, if an official asks a player or a coach to make sure masks are being worn please respect them.
6. Teams will chase after their own volleyballs during their warm-up time. Line-judges should not chase after the game ball during their officiating time. Line-judging flags will not be used unless an officiating team brings their own set.
7. Water fountains will not be used so please plan accordingly. You will be allowed to fill up your water bottles in the concession stand.
8. Teams will not switch sides of the net after each set. Teams will recognize each other before and after the match with a hand wave across the net. The R1 (lead official) has the discretion to ask the teams to switch sides of the net during the third set if they feel like one side has an advantage.
9. We are asking each team to bring their own writing utensils when keeping score. **After each match the officiating team will be asked to spray down the scorer's table area with disinfectant and towels that will be provided.** Coaches, please oversee this and tell the players that they need to do this as part of their job requirements.
10. The officials will be wiping off the game ball after each match.

11. Doors will open at 7:15 a.m. on Sunday. Please go directly to your court so we know you have arrived.
12. The Court of Champions is located straight ahead as you enter the facility. This gym will be used for a basketball tournament. The Fieldhouse is located down the hallway and then left at the lamp post for the Bank of Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin Ducks, Noah's Ark, Moosejaw, MACS, Mt. Olympus and Tommy Bartlett/Monk's court. These courts will be used for the volleyball tournament.
13. As you enter the facility please use the doors to the left. Please have correct change when paying to enter the facility. We do accept credit cards as well. The prices for the tournament are \$7.00 for adults and \$3.00 for K-12 Grade. There is no fee to park on city streets or parking lots until April 1st.
